Helping to remove self sown oak saplings from the rough grassland and creating log piles for insects.

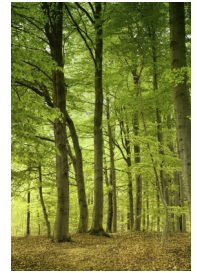
Clearing back the brambles, nettles and dead elms along the boundary with Dunsborough Park.
